1 Situation

1.1 Political situation

We get more and more control over the mediterranean sea and its islands. Only on Altis there is a resistance group naming themselves "FIA" that hinders our conquest. They fight a guerilla battle against us in order to make our lives as hard as possible. In that they have been more successful than any other group before them. FIA uses the uneven terrain on Altis to their advantage and can thus strike sensible blows against our forces. More than anything the decentralized organization makes it very hard to extinguish them.

NATO tries to stop our advancements and still firmly holds the greek mainland. We noticed reconnaissance flights every now and then that supposedly aim to prepare a military blow against Altis and the surrounding islands. Until now there haven't been any open battles though. NATO is well aware that they can't afford an open conflict with us as there is no UN-mandate for this.

1.2 Enemy situation

FIA maintains multiple hideouts in the south-east that we haven't been able to locate yet. Therefore we have to assume that they might crawl out from everywhere at anytime.

We know that there has been a helicopter - most likely NATO - that had to perform an emergency landing in the south-east of the island. The majority of its crew is probably still alive. We assume that this has been a helicopter manned with well-trained soldiers on a reconnaissance mission. We also assume that NATO will start a CSAR-Mission into this area in order to evacuate their soldiers. We don't know if FIA knows about this as well.

1.3 Friendly forces

There are no allied forces in the area of operation.

1.4 Own forces

We command several units that are scattered throughout the entire area of operation:

- The leading team and the first squad are located at our reconnaissance post on the south-eastern peninsular (coordinate 122-088). They have a MRAP and a truck at their disposal.
- The second Squad reported to hold positions in the north-east of Kavala (coordinate 052-141) together with a T-100 tank and a HMG-Team. Apart from the tank they also have a MRAP and a truck there.
- A third squad watches the Zaros-bay together with a scout-team (coordinate 083-100).

They are equipped with a truck and a light strike vehicle.

- Another scout-team is stationed at Kavala's harbor (coordinate 031-129). They also have a light strike vehicle. Furthermore our reconnaissance helicopter (type MH-6) is also in this harbor.

We reckon with no civilians in the area of operations.

2 Assignment

Our primary goal is to enhance our position against FIA. In order to do so we should capture and hold a few strategic key locations:

- Radio tower on the mountain Magos (045-154)
- Checkpoint between Kavala and Neri (039-122)
- Observation point on the Riga mountain (092-114)
- Castle on the southern peninsula.

A secondary assignment is to try to capture the downed Helicopter as well as the crew. Remember though that they are much more valuable if we capture them alive.
